Resurrection rolls: Have your kids help you roll a large marshmallow in melted butter. Next roll the marshmallow in a mixture of 1 tbsp. sugar and 1 tsp. cinnamon. Then place the marshmallow in a crescent triangle. Wrap triangle around the marshmallow making sure to pinch the seams together tightly so that the marshmallow won't ooze through. Bake according to the package directions. The marshmallow represents Jesus being laid in the tomb which is the crescent roll. The butter and sugar and cinnamon mixture represents the oil and spices that his body was anointed with upon burial. After baking, break open the tomb to see that the body of Christ is no longer there.

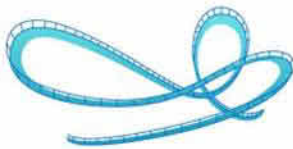
Next time you give your child a donut tell them that it is in the shape of an "O", which reminds
